





Metasys ABCS Learning Path



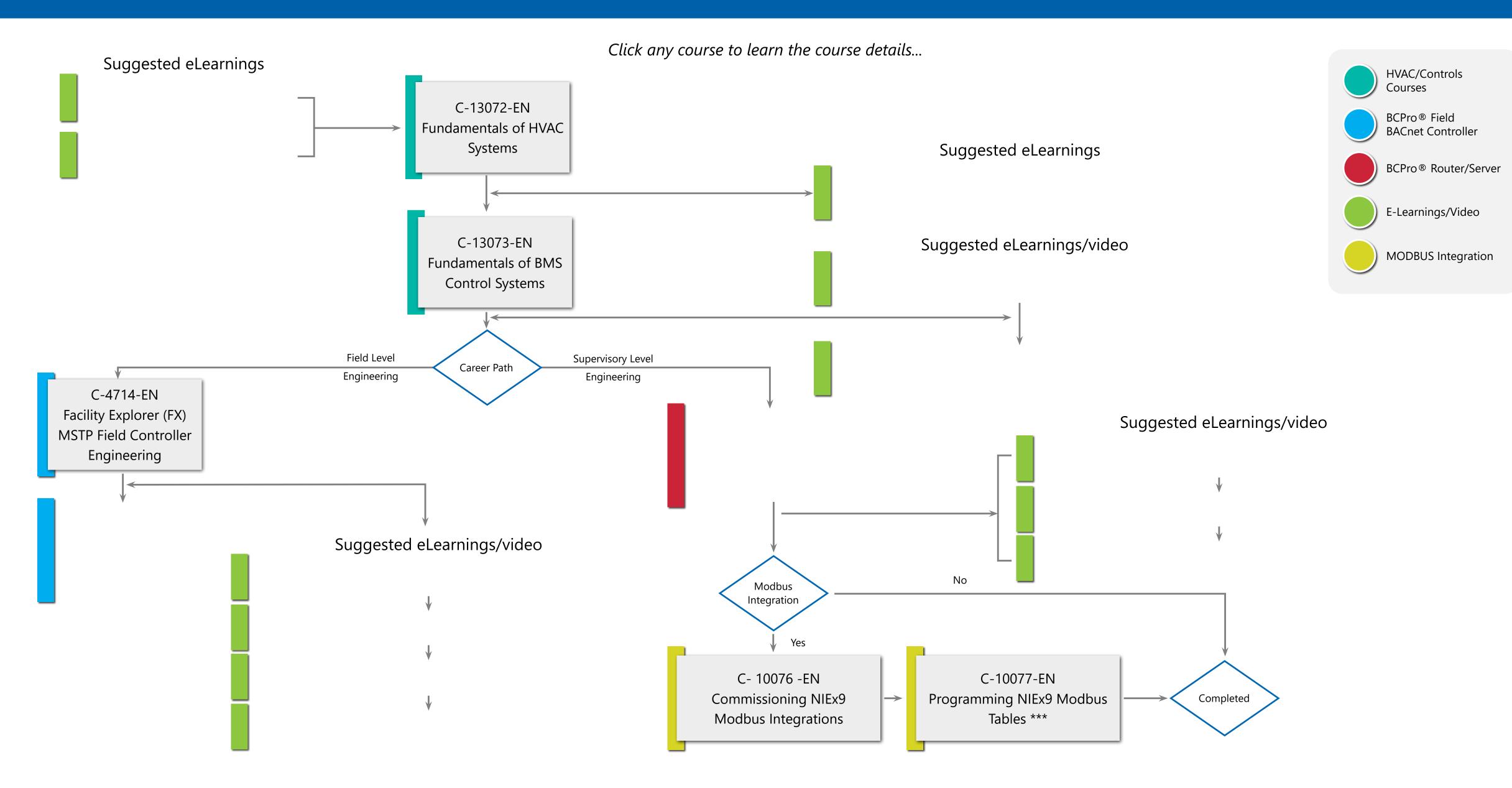
Facility Explorer (FX) ABCS Learning Path
